

# SCHOOL DRESS CODE 2011-14

---

## GOALS

- To have all our students wearing clothing using the school colours – plain navy blue and sky blue.
- To incorporate Sunsmart design features - hats, short sleeves and collars.
- To create a feeling of unity and school ownership amongst students.
- To be recognised as a Lockwood South Primary School group when moving in the wider community. This would include excursions and special school events.

## School Context

- The school uniform colours are **plain navy blue and plain sky blue**. Wearing the school colours is compulsory at Lockwood South Primary School.
- Parents are free to make or buy the uniforms for their children.
- There is a wide selection of uniform items from which to choose available through the Office at the school.
- Student hair accessories need to be plain navy or plain sky blue. E.g. Ribbons and headbands.
- Hair shoulder length or longer is required to be tied back; to support the management of headlice.
- Denim, ‘designer’ and clothing with stripes is not within the uniform guidelines.
- *Clearly label all items of clothing*

## Sunsmart Dress Code Requirements

- As a SunSmart School, the wearing of sun hats is compulsory from the beginning September till the end of April. Lockwood South broadbrim and bucket approved hats are available from the Office.
- “No Hat” means restricted play areas (verandah areas) and no outside PE or sport activities.
- Lockwood South Primary School is a Baseball Hat Free Zone.

## Dress Code and Student Safety

- Shoes should protect the feet and be appropriate for Physical Education. Thongs, ‘rip-up’ sandals and high/wedge heels are not permitted.
- Stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears, plus watches are the only acceptable jewellery.
- Make up is NOT part of our Dress Code.
- The following garments are considered to make up the Lockwood School uniform: -:

### Navy:

Short sleeve polo shirt  
Long sleeve polo shirt  
Bomber jacket  
Windcheater  
Track pants/ pants  
Shorts

### Sky blue:

Short sleeve polo shirt  
Long sleeve polo shirt

### Navy/White:

Check summer dress

### Footwear:

Black, navy blue or brown shoes/sandals  
Runners

## **Policy Implementation**

All children will be expected to wear school uniform. A telephone call or note should be provided by parents to explain why a student is not wearing uniform.

### **PROCEDURE IF A CHILD ATTENDS SCHOOL WITHOUT UNIFORM**

If a student is at school without the correct school jumper then the Principal or a staff member will provide the student with a school jumper to wear for the day.

Ongoing issue- A School /parent meeting will be arranged to develop an appropriate way forward.

*Children who transfer in will be given one season to obtain uniform.*

### **EXCURSIONS**

Children are required to be in compulsory school uniform colours on all excursions and other events that take them out of the school ground. From the beginning of September till the end of April, a hat is also required.
