Breakfast Club will run 3 days a week, every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from **8am to 8:40am.**

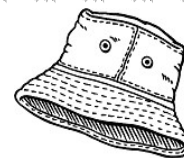
Scholastic Book Club
