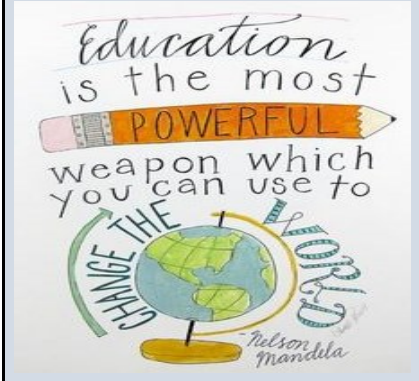

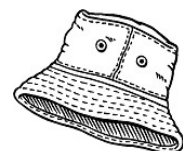
Uniform Order
