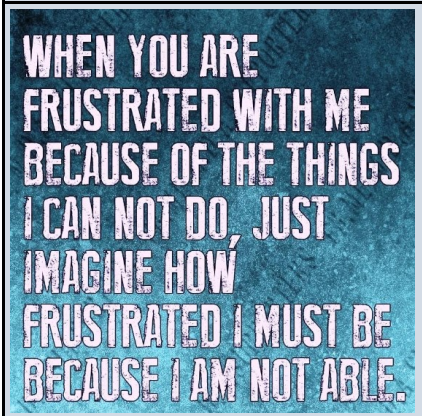

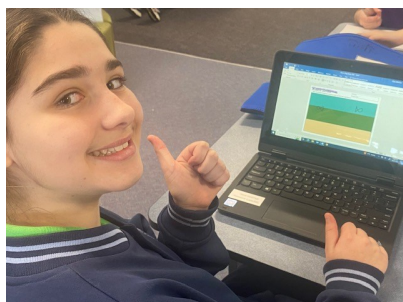
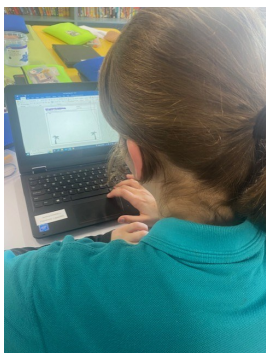

The Grade 6 Leadership sell ice-creams at the start of Recess each day.

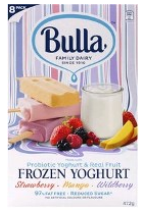
