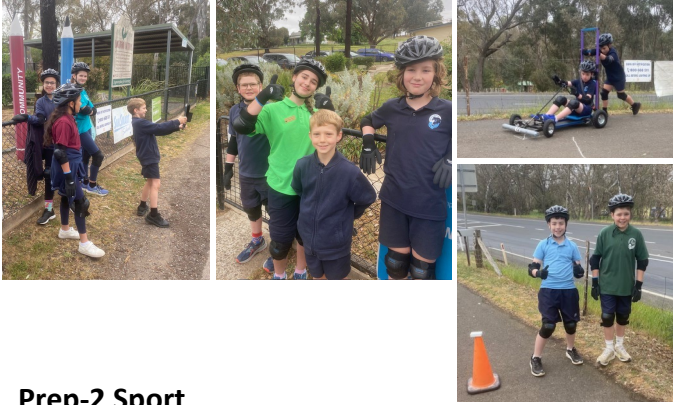

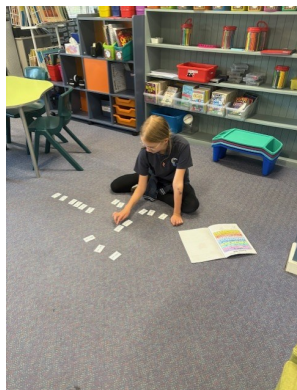


Melaleuca News
