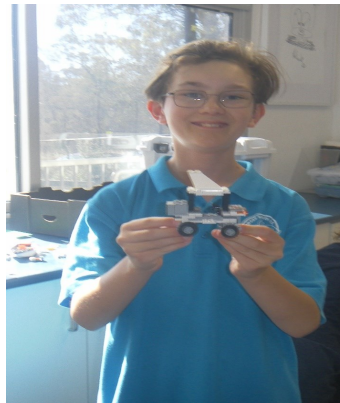
Vic Kids Eat Well Program
