Smile Squad oral health packs

All children deserve a healthy smile, and the Smile Squad free school dental program is working hard to help make this happen.



Your child(ren) will soon receive a free oral health pack to bring home. The pack contains a toothbrush, full-sized toothpaste, and an oral health brochure. Please take a moment to read the brochure—it is full of useful tips to help your family eat well, drink well, and clean well for life.

Standard strength toothpaste

Smile Squad provides standard-strength fluoride toothpaste, which is generally recommended for ages six and over unless advised otherwise by a dental or trained health professional.

If your child is under six, please speak with a dental or trained health professional to determine whether this toothpaste is suitable. Alternatively, you may choose to put the toothpaste aside until they turn six or give it to another family member.

Do I need to attend my child's appointment?

No, you do not need to attend your child's appointment. You are welcome to attend if you wish, and you can choose to take your child to a community dental clinic if that suits your family better.

Hats

It is Hat wearing time of year again: 1st September to 31st April as part of our SunSmart Policy, wearing hats is compulsory, if your child does not have a hat, they play under the undercover area.



OSHC

In OSHC this week, we have created large shapes using the magnetic shaped pieces, and more Mr. Potato Head characters. We have played games of Match Up, Jenga, and completed jigsaws. Our art activity this week was mindfulness colouring – colouring in whatever we felt like.
