MARC Van— Commencing next Tuesday 21st February

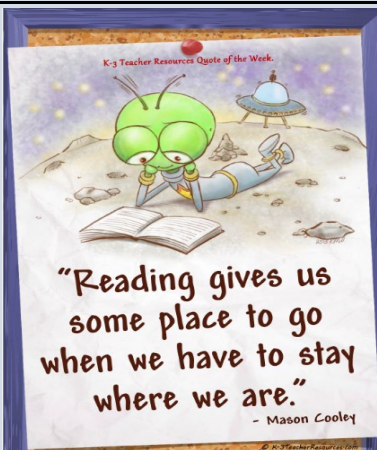

Yoghurt Fruit Mini ices are now available at \$1.50

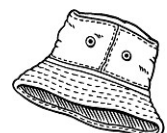


Hats/Hair ties:
