Sunny and Nai Nai can't wait for their town's annual dragon parade. But when the loongs don't wake up, Sunny must find a way to save the family tradition.


Dragon Dance is a story of hope, resilience and creativity, and a celebration of the much-loved Chinese dragons on the Australian goldfields.

Uniform Order



