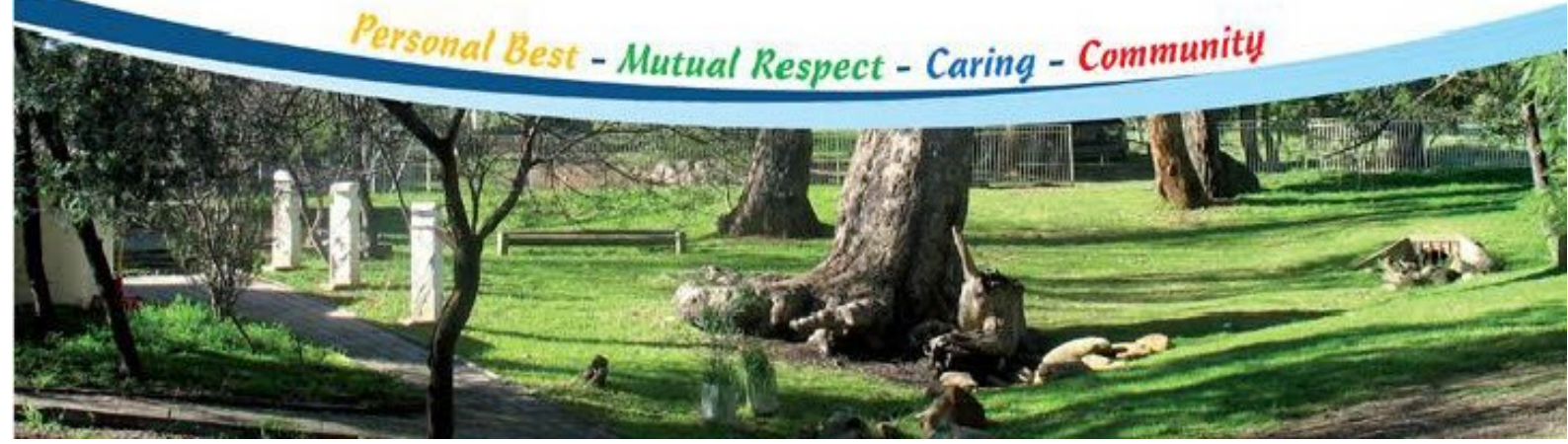

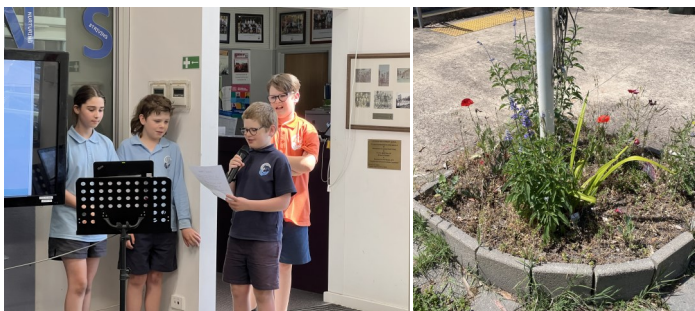
### Sporting Schools Program
