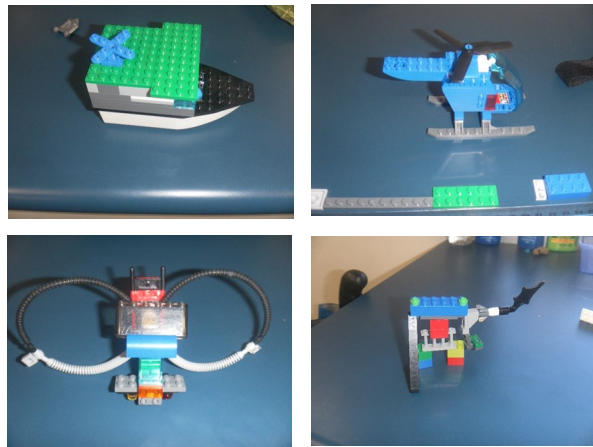
A huge shout out to the Terry Floyd Foundation once again for their continued support to our school, we received 2 new racquets as well as a fresh food box.
