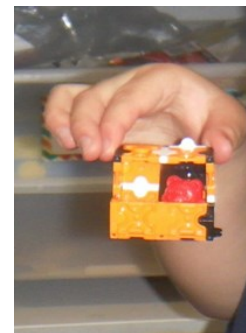
Music In Schools Dancers came to Lockwood South P.S.

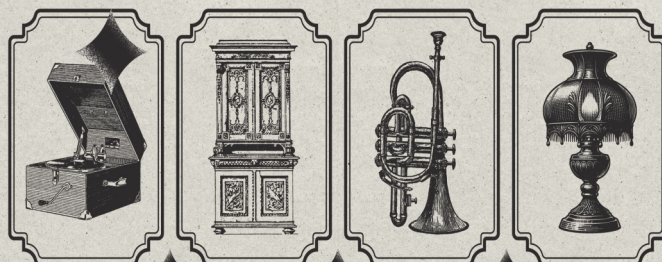
