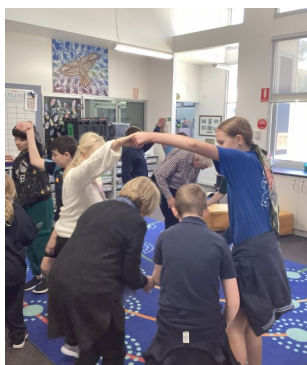


2026 Enrolments

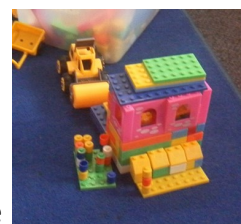

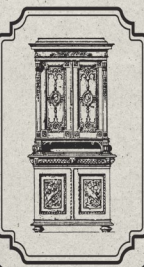
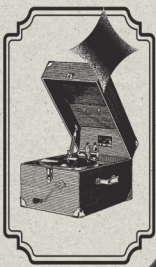
